



ESA Requirements for Inspection of a Site for Reconnection After a Grow House or Meth Lab Operation

For Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) personnel to enter a premise for the purpose of conducting an inspection for the reconnection of power after a facility had been used as a Grow House or Meth Lab, ESA requires a professional report declaring the property hazard free and fit for occupancy.

Note: The company performing the declaration must be independent from the company performing the remedial work (clean up).

The report, along with this checklist and the completed *Grow House Report Cover Sheet* must be sent to the Electrical Safety Authority by the company that performed the testing.

Note: When the facility had been structurally altered, a signed statement from a Professional Engineer, complete with his/her Professional Engineering stamp, declaring the facility is structurally sound and is safe to enter is also required.
